Simon sent in this report "The Club capped another exceptional season for the club's young athletes winning the fourth and final MYAL meeting at StoneX making it 4 wins out of 4 and ensuring we retained the League title in convincing style. This season had also included the extra challenge of leading clubs Harrow and Thames Valley Harriers also joining the league.

There were age group wins for the U11 Boys, U15 Boys, U11 Girls, U15 Girls and U17 Women. There were also 12 individual event wins Kingston Bennett (U11B 75m and L), Nyah Brown (U13G HJ), Ivy Paitoo (U13G SP and JT), Gabriel Edwards (U13B L), Milli Bridgman Athanasatos (U15G L), Ndidi Stewart Fraser (U17W HJ and SP), Trey Corlis (U17M HJ), Ake Akpan (U17M SP), Marcel Baczek (U17M JT) and U15G 4x100m. Trey and Ndidi both set new League bests with Ndidi's 32.69m in the U17 Hammer also a New Club AG record as were the U17W and U15G 4x100m teams performances. Indeed, the U15 Girl's time of 51.23s is a new Overall Club Record.

The U11 Girls won their match with Shiya Daley performing strongly in the sprint and long jump. Grace Wood however showed her versatility running our fastest 75m and 800m. Kingston Bennett was the standout performer for the Boys winning his 3 events and helping the relay team finish 2nd. Only 5 U13 Girls were available but Ivy, Nyah, Maya, Lila and Ava still secured 2nd place. The U13 Boys 2nd place include the usual excellent performances form Gabriel but also worthy of mention was Lincoln's 1.30m in the high jump after running the 1500m. The U15 Girls completed their 4th win with Elkie contributing 58 of the teams 209 pts in the throwing events. The U15 Boys also completed another win despite no event wins however there were a host of PBs including all those in the 100m. The U17 Women saw Dee win both Shot and Hammer as well as contribute to the relay in a fantastic all-round performance with the team winning by a considerable margin. The U17 men only comprised 5 with Trey, Milton, Akpan, Artie and Marcel finishing in a close 3rd place.

Well done to all the Young Athletes who have competed for the club this season and to Ruth, Mary, Israel, Russell and Rachel for managing the team. Thank you to all the parents and officials for also giving their time to help the Club achieve this stunning achievement."


2022 Track and Field Fixtures
