# Meeting Report:- Middlesex Road Relays, Hayes 11.9.22

September saw the traditional road relays to open the winter season, with the club securing two wins in the U15 and U17 girls with Issy Watkins and Amy Kirk securing fastest laps in their respective races.

Last season we had no U11s so Seb McNeely produced a welcome run to finish 10th in the Boys race. The U13's were all debuting in the race with Rory Willis running our fastest leg and 9th fastest overall to finish in 4th place. Interestingly their time of 36.36 was 30s faster than our U13 Boys winning time last year. For the girls Caitlin Roberts ran the 9th fastest leg overall as the team finished in 6th place.

The U15 Boys secured our first medal with 2nd place thanks to Koppany Szentes and Dylan Mills recording the 6th and 7th fastest legs overall with Ben Ryan taking 20s off his time last year crossing the line behind St Mary's Richmond. A young U15 Girls team went one better with Amy Kirk improving her time last year by 30s to record the fastest lap in the race Mia Rosen and Lettice Gundry both ran well to secure the gold medal.



Despite valiant runs from Fred Beale, George Saint and Greg Berrisford-Sweet who all recorded times of 11.00 or below our U17 Mens team could only finish 6th. The U17 womens team however secured the gold medal with Issy Watkins the fastest lap. Ruby supported Issy and Hattie who had both turned out for the Seniors in the SAL the day before.

Simon Baker reports on our two winning girls teams from the Middlesex Road Relays heading to Crystal Palace to take part in the 3 x 3000m Southern Road Relays:

"While many clubs had opted for the alternative races at Aldershot there was still plenty of talent on show. The Young U15 girls team finished in 7th, a great result considering all three were in the 1st race as U15s. Lettice Gundry started the team off passing over to Amy Kirk in 9th place who managed to improve the team into 7th place with Kiara Corkin continuing to push they finished only 7s behind 6th placed VP&TH.

"Our U17 women have had a strong track season and demonstrated their potential for this season's cross-country by taking the gold medal. Hattie Munday got the team off to a great start in 3rd place. Ruby Walls managed to overtake the teams ahead which allowed Izzy Watkins, the Southern U17W 800m Champion, to move further way with the 2nd fastest leg of the race and take gold for the team." The U17s finished 43-seconds ahead of second placed South London Harriers.

**Parking**:- Approximately 150 spaces at Ashton Playing Fields (IG8 8AA). Parking in the vicinity of Claybury Park is impossible or extremely limited. Please look out for any restrictions and do not block access to any properties. There is virtually no parking in the Roding Lane North area because of residential parking. You are advised to park at Ashton Playing Fields and make the 10 minute walk to the course. You MUST NOT park on the grass triangle in Roding Lane North so as to avoid confrontation with residents. Any inconsiderate parking could jeopardise the future of the races.

Direction:- To walk to the course from Ashton Playing Fields, take Gaynes Hill Road (opposite) to Roding Lane North (10 Minutes). Additional Notes:- For car drivers, use the A406 eastbound /M11 northbound junction and branch left onto A1400 signposted Gants Hill and then A113 at roundabout signposted Chigwell onto Chigwell Road. Ashton Playing Fields IG8 8AA is 800 metres away. Course Details:- Parkland setting , undulating course, with one steep climb on each large lap on grass and woodland paths. On certain sections the course width is limited. Care is required on the narrow downhill start. Times:-
